WHO WE ARE


Formed in 2021, the FoodCare Coalition is comprised of community-based organizations (CBOs) and health systems working together to rethink the way food insecurity and health are currently addressed. The original pilot program was designed to support the growing intersection of CBOs and primary care clinics. The aim was to build bridges across nontraditional partners to address food security and promote the whole health of children and families in Milwaukee, WI.

OUR FRAMEWORK

Goal 1: Strengthen communication between food pantries, food banks and primary care clinics to increase food security and health of children and families. **Objective 1:** Develop and/or support a system of bidirectional referrals and information sharing between food pantries, food banks and medical homes by building capacity. **Objective 2:** Assist with relationship-building between food pantries, food banks, and clinic staff members, with an emphasis on understanding on another's priorities and areas of focus in working with children and families, and opportunities for improvement.
